- 90-272 Motion by Councilman Joseph V. Kosinski, supported by Councilman Robert L. Brown, that the City Council adopt the General Government Fiscal 1990-91 balanced budget in the amount of \$24,881,123.00.

- 90-273 Motion by Councilman Gary P. Blackburn, supported by Councilman Jerome P. Chismar, that the tax levy for the 1990-91 fiscal year be set at 7.6749 mills.

Motion adopted.

- 90-274 Motion by Councilman Robert L. Brown, supported by Councilman Gary P. Blackburn, that 2.1020 mills be levied to finance the voter approved Act 345 Fire and Police Pension Plan for the fiscal year 1990-91 in the amount of \$1,634,827.00.

- 90-275 Motion by Councilman Jerome P. Chismar, supported by Councilman Joseph F. Kosinski, that the City Council levy an additional 2.7087 mills on the State Equalized Valuation for financing garbage and rubbish disposal for the fiscal year 1990-91.

- 90-276 Motion by Councilman Gary P. Blackburn, supported by Councilman Robert L. Brown, that the City Council levy an additional 1.8059 mills on the State Equalized Valuation of Public Safety, as approved by the voters of the City of Dearborn Heights, for the fiscal year 1990-91.

- 90-277 Motion by Councilman Joseph F. Kosinski, supported by Councilman Gary P. Blackburn, that the City Council levy an additional assessment for the fiscal year 1990-91 of 0.1650 mills to satisfy debt requirements established for the Ecorse Creek Pollution Abatement Drain No. 1 with the stipulation that this assessment be collected on the December 1, 1990 County and School Tax Bill.

- 90-280 Motion by Councilman Robert L. Brown, supported by Councilman Joseph F. Kosinski, that the City Council approve the 1990-91 lump sum budget for the District Court in the amount of \$859,000.00. Salaries not to exceed amount specified in the budget.
