

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE DEARBORN HEIGHTS CITY COUNCIL

JUNE 1, 1992

- 92-289 The meeting was called to order at 8:24 p.m., by Council Chairman Daniel S. Paletko.

Roll call showed the following:

- 92-290 Motion by Councilwoman Ruth A. Canfield, supported by Councilman Gary P. Blackburn, that the City Council adopt the General Government Fiscal 1992-93 balanced budget in the amount of \$23,661,862.00.

Motion unanimously adopted.

- 92-291 Motion by Councilman Joseph F. Kosinski, supported by Councilman Robert L. Brown, that the tax levy for the 1992-93 fiscal year be set at 7.5368 mills.

Motion unanimously adopted.

- 92-292 Motion by Councilman Robert L. Brown, supported by Councilman Joseph V. Kosinski, that 2.0309 mills be levied to finance the voter approved Act 345 Fire and Police Pension Plan for the fiscal year 1992-93 in the amount of \$1,696,287.00.

Motion unanimously adopted.

- 92-293 Motion by Councilman Joseph V. Kosinski, supported by Councilman Robert L. Brown, that the City Council levy an additional 2.6600 mills on the State Equalized Valuation for financing garbage and rubbish disposal for the fiscal year 1992-93.

- 92-294 Motion by Councilman Gary P. Blackburn, supported by Councilwoman Ruth A. Canfield, that the City Council levy an additional 1.7734 mills on the State equalized Valuation of Public Safety, as approved by the voters of the City of Dearborn Heights, for the fiscal year 1992-93.

- 92-295 Motion by Councilman David C. Brunell, supported by Councilman Robert L. Brown, that the City Council levy an additional assessment for the fiscal year 1992-93 of .1560 mills to satisfy debt requirements established for the Ecorse Creek Pollution Abatement Drain No. 1 with the stipulation that this assessment be collected on the December 1, 1992 County and School Tax Bill.

- 92-296 Motion by Councilman Robert L. Brown, supported by Councilman Joseph F. Kosinski, that the millage approved for solid waste disposal by the electorate in July, 1985, be levied at .8866 mills.

- 92-297 Motion by Councilman Joseph V. Kosinski, supported by Councilwoman Ruth A. Canfield that the City Council levy an additional assessment of .1248 mills for Sewage Disposal Bond Payment for the fiscal year 1992-93.

- 92-298 Motion by Councilman Joseph F. Kosinski, supported by Councilman Robert L. Brown, that the City Council levy an additional assessment of .0978 mills for 1971 Sanitation Debt for the fiscal year 1992-93.

- 92-299 Motion by Councilman David C. Brunell, supported by Councilman Joseph F. Kosinski, that the City Council approve the 1992-93 lump sum budget for the District Court in the amount of \$992,535.00. Salaries not to exceed amount specified in the budget.
