

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE DEARBORN HEIGHTS CITY COUNCIL

JANUARY 6, 1997

97-001 The meeting was called to order at 8:02 p.m., by Council Chairman Joseph V. Kosinski.

Roll Call showed the following:

The following is a copy of a motion adopted at the Regular Meeting of the Dearborn Heights City Council held on December 10, 1996.

CM 96-585 Motion by Councilman Paletko, seconded by Councilman Zulinski, to request Chairman Kosinski set a special meeting, January 6, 1997 for the purpose of interviewing prospective candidates for the council vacancy. Further, that the City Clerk place an ad outlining the procedure for applicants. Motion unanimously adopted.

97-003 Motion by Councilwoman Horvath, seconded by Councilman Baron, to receive, note and file CM 96-585.

City Clerk Sheridan read the official notice of the Special Council Meeting published in the City's official newspaper.

The City Council of Dearborn Heights will be hosting presentations of registered and qualified electors of the City of Dearborn Heights who demonstrate interest and ability to fulfill the duties of a City Councilperson. All material submitted will be treated with confidentiality, however, documents received from the person eventually selected may become public. Evaluations will consist of a maximum 10-minute presentation by the applicant to the Council. The public presentation session will be held at a Special City Council meeting scheduled for Monday, January 6, 1997, at 8:00 p.m. at the Dearborn Heights City Hall, 6045 Fenton, Dearborn Heights, Michigan.
