RE: Councilman Saab - Resolution Regarding Amendments to the Budget to Address the \$750,000 Reduction Discussed at the Budget Hearing

In response to the administration's failure to implement the necessary budget cuts, I move to introduce the following amendments to fulfill the \$750,000 reduction that was proposed during the budget hearing:

1. Wade Trim: amend and reduce the budget allocation by \$150,000.
2. Plante Moran: Amend and Reduce the budget allocation by \$120,000.
3. Mayor's Office: Eliminate the part-time position.
4. Legal Fees: Amend and Reduce the budget by corporation counsel outside counsel to \$75,000.
5. Director of Operations, Police Department: amend this vacant position from the budget, with the funds coming back to the General fund. The mayor may bring back the position if needed in the future with a qualified person with councils approval. The mayor is not to introduce any new position without city councils approval that currently is not part of act 78.

These adjustments are necessary due to the administration's lack of action in addressing the budgetary concerns previously raised and voted on by the Dearborn Heights City Council.

RE: Council Chair Pro Tem Ahmad - Resolution Opposing the Transportation and Storage of Radioactive Materials in Van Buren Township, Wayne County

WHEREAS, the health and safety of the citizens of Wayne County is of utmost importance; and

WHEREAS, the transportation and storage of radioactive materials poses significant risks to public health, safety, and the environment;

WHEREAS, it has come to our attention that radioactive waste is slated to be transported to a hazardous waste facility in Van Buren Township, Wayne County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of Dearborn Heights opposes the transportation and storage of radioactive materials in Van Buren Township, Wayne County, and urges the Wayne County Board of Commissioners the State of Michigan, and federal authorities to take all necessary measures to prevent the transportation and storage of radioactive materials in the region;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council of Dearborn Heights requests regular updates and information on any proposals or actions related to the transportation and storage of radioactive materials in Van Buren Township, Wayne County;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council of Dearborn Heights stands in solidarity with the citizens of Van Buren Township and surrounding communities in opposing the storage of radioactive materials in the region.
